

COOKIE POLICY

This is the Cookie Policy of the Critical Infrastructure Information Sharing and Analysis Centre (referred to as CI-ISAC, "we", "us" or "our" in this cookie policy). This cookie policy will inform you as to how we use cookies on our website.

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file that can be stored on your computer when you visit websites. Information is saved in this text file to ensure a smooth and interactive experience on the internet.

Cookies usually also have an expiration date. Some cookies are automatically deleted when you close your browser (session cookies), while others can be stored longer on your computer, sometimes until you delete them manually (permanent cookies).

Why we use cookies?

CI-ISAC uses a single type of analytical cookie on www.ci-isac.com.au. We install analytical cookies to track and quantify the visits (traffic) on the website. We use this information only to improve the content of our website or as a basis for determining topics of interest.

Primarily, we use third-party analytical cookies that send data to Google Analytics to track website usage. Website users who do not want their data collected with Google Analytics can install the Google Analytics opt-out browser add-on. This add-on instructs the Google Analytics JavaScript (ga.js, analytics.js, and dc.js) running on websites to prohibit sending information to Google Analytics. To opt out of Google Analytics for the web, visit <http://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout> and install the add-on for your browser. Check directly with the manufacturer of your browser to determine the conditions on which add-on functions on your browser and whether add-ons will function properly on the browser version that you are using.

Which cookies are used on www.ci-isac.com.au?

1. **_ga cookie** - used to identify unique website users and expires after two years
2. **_gat cookie** - used to throttle the users' request rate, and expires after one minute
3. **_gid cookie** - used to identify store information on how visitors use the CI-ISAC website, and expires after 24 hours

How can I see which cookies are installed on my device and how can I remove them?

If you want to know which cookies are installed on your device or if you want to delete certain cookies, you can use the available settings in your browser. Your browser settings may allow only certain cookies to be deleted.
